**1 liter contains: Albendazole 3000 mg.**

**White tablet, scored on one side, marked "BIO" on the other side. White speckles may be present.**

**Indications for Use**

**Used in cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, horses, donkeys, mules and rabbits for the treatment of:**

**Nematodosis**

**Cestodosis**

**Trematodosis**

**Pulmonary helminthiasis**

**Gastrointestinal invasions caused by liver flukes**

**Larval and adult helminths**

**Dosage and Administration**

**Administered orally, individually or by group method, mixed with feed.**

**Cattle, sheep, goats and pigs: 1 tablet per 300–400 kg body weight (7.5 g per 35–40 kg body weight).**

**Rabbits: 1 tablet per 6–8 kg body weight (10 kg body weight).**

**Contraindications**

Do not use in case of individual hypersensitivity, debilitated animals, or during the first third of pregnancy.

#### Side Effects

No side effects observed when used at therapeutic doses.

#### Storage Conditions

Store in a dry place protected from light at temperatures not exceeding 25°C.

#### Shelf Life

3 years.

4 tablets in blister

5 blisters in carton box
