

Camphor Ointment 10%

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Ointment for external topical use, for veterinary application.

Composition

1 g contains:

Active substance: Camphor powder – 100 mg

Description

Colorless to whitish ointment with the characteristic odor of camphor.

Indications

Preparation for external use. Exhibits anti-inflammatory action.

Used in animals for the treatment of bursitis, myositis, and in cows during the dry period for the treatment of subclinical mastitis.

Adverse Reactions

When used according to the instructions, no side effects are observed.

Hypersensitivity to the components of the product may occur.

Contraindications

None reported.

Target Species

Farm and domestic animals.

Method of Administration and Dosage

The ointment should be rubbed into the affected area of the skin and surrounding tissue or applied as a gauze dressing.

Applications and rubbing should be carried out 2–3 times daily until recovery.

Special Warnings

Persons administering the veterinary medicinal product must follow general rules of personal hygiene and safety.

Overdose

No symptoms of overdose have been reported.

Specific Effects

No specific effects associated with first use or withdrawal have been identified.

Interaction with Other Medicinal Products

Do not mix with other veterinary medicinal products.

Use During Pregnancy and Lactation

The product may be used during pregnancy and lactation.

Withdrawal Period

0 days.

Storage Conditions

Store in a dry place protected from light at a temperature not exceeding 20°C.

Shelf Life

2 years.

Packaging

20 g ointment in polyethylene tube.

Pharmacological Group

Antiseptic, anti-inflammatory agent.
