

GLICOGEL (Glicogel)

I. General Information

Glicogel is an antiseptic product intended for daily udder care in cattle and small ruminants.

Composition

Glycerin, fir essential oil, camphor, menthol, methylene blue, ethanol alcohol, propylene glycol, HEC (hydroxyethyl cellulose), citric acid, distilled water.

Packaging

1 L polyethylene bottle.

Storage Conditions

Store in a dry, dark place at a temperature not exceeding 20°C.

Shelf life: 2 years.

II. Biological Properties

Glicogel is designed for daily udder care. The active components provide moisturizing, softening, and antiseptic effects on the skin.

- Glycerin – moisturizes and softens the skin.
- Methylene blue – exhibits antibacterial and antifungal activity.
- Fir essential oil – provides pronounced antiseptic action, reduces swelling and inflammation, promotes skin regeneration.
- Camphor – anti-inflammatory and disinfectant agent; improves blood circulation.

- Menthol – has anti-inflammatory properties and provides a long-lasting cooling effect.

III. Indications

Glicogel is used for daily udder care. It promotes skin regeneration in cases of increased mastitis risk, helps maintain skin hydration and provides a cooling effect.

IV. Directions for Use

Apply a small amount of gel to clean, dry udder skin after each milking. Massage gently in circular motions until fully absorbed.
