

Propolis Ointment (Propolis Ointment)

External-use ointment for veterinary medicine

Composition

1 g of ointment contains active substance:

- Propolis extract – 24 mg

Description

Yellow or yellow-brown ointment with a mild specific odor.

Pharmacological properties

External-use preparation for farm animals, dogs, and cats.

- Exhibits anti-inflammatory action
- Promotes wound healing
- After skin application, diffuses into sebaceous and sweat glands
- Gradually absorbs and accelerates the resorption of inflammatory products
- Stimulates growth of granulation tissue and wound epithelialization

Indications for use

Infected wounds, burns, eczema, vaginitis, mastitis, dermatitis, bursitis, scars, cracks.

Adverse reactions

No adverse reactions have been observed.

Increased sensitivity to the product components may occur.

Contraindications

None identified.

Target species

Farm animals, dogs, and cats.

Dosage and administration

Apply a thin layer of ointment to a clean white cloth or gauze and place it on the affected area.

Bandaging and rubbing should be carried out 2–3 times daily until recovery.

The ointment may also be gently rubbed directly onto the affected area and surrounding tissues.

If necessary, tampons may be used.

Special instruction:

For hoof injuries, a warm compress with the ointment is recommended.

Special warnings

Persons using the veterinary medicinal product must follow personal hygiene and safety rules.

Overdose

No overdose symptoms have been reported.

Specificity of action

No specific effects have been identified upon first application or discontinuation.

Pregnancy and lactation

The product may be used during pregnancy and lactation.

Withdrawal period

0 days.

Storage conditions

Store in a dry place, protected from light, at a temperature not exceeding 20°C.

Keep out of reach of children.

Shelf life

2 years.

- 20 g ointment in polyethylene tube
- 0.5 kg ointment in polyethylene container

Pharmacotherapeutic group

Antiseptic, anti-inflammatory agent.
