Rodenticide for rodent control

## I. General Information

Ratex is a rodenticide solution used for preparing poisoned baits to control rodents.

Composition:

- Bromadiolone – 0.5%

Formulation / Packaging:

- 20 ml
  - 100 ml
  - 1 L
- (Other sizes available)

Each package includes labeling with manufacturer details, composition, instructions, batch number, production date, and expiry date.

Storage conditions:

- Store in a dry, cool place (0°C to 18°C)
- Keep out of reach of children

Shelf life: 12 months

## II. Biological Properties

Ratex is an anticoagulant rodenticide effective against:

- mice
- rats
- field rodents

Used as bait placed near burrows to create a toxic effect.

### III. Directions for Use and Dosage

Mix 20 ml of Ratex with 0.5 kg of bait:

- wheat
- potato flour
- meat, etc.

Sugar or milk powder can be added. Mix thoroughly.

Divide into portions and place in bait stations or covered containers.

Indoors:

- mice: 10–25 g per 2–15 m<sup>2</sup>
- rats: 50–100 g per 15–20 m<sup>2</sup>

Agricultural fields:

- field mice: 100 g per 300 m<sup>2</sup>

Monitoring:

- Check after 1–2 days
- Then weekly
- Refill consumed bait
- Repeat until complete control

### IV. Safety Precautions

- Use protective clothing, gloves, and goggles
- Avoid contact with skin and mucous membranes
- In case of contact – rinse with plenty of water
- Do not eat or smoke during use
- Wash hands thoroughly after work
