

Antimosquito

Insect repellent spray, aerosol (against mosquitoes, wasps, ticks)

Composition

Active ingredient: Ethyl Butylacetylaminopropionate 20%

Properties

The active ingredient contained in the product, derived from the natural amino acid β -alanine (β -alanin), has pronounced repellent properties and drives insects away from treated skin, hair, and textiles (clothing, bed linen, curtains, carpets, sleeping bags, tents, etc.).

The product is effective against ticks – carriers of Lyme borreliosis (a serious infectious disease); mosquitoes, sand flies, midges (their bites cause itching and may lead to bacterial infections); and wasps (whose stings may cause severe allergic reactions).

Indications

The aerosol is intended to repel mosquitoes, sand flies, midges, flies, fleas, and ticks.

- Duration of repellent effect against mosquitoes, sand flies, midges, and flies: up to 4 hours after application.
- Duration of repellent effect against ticks and fleas: up to 2 hours after application.

Method of Application

Spray a small amount of the repellent onto exposed areas of the body from a distance of approximately 20 cm.

Apply to textile surfaces from a distance of 5 cm (do not apply directly to synthetic fabrics).

- Children from 3 years: once daily.
- Children from 12 years and adults: twice daily.

Side Effects

Not established.

Important Information

Use of the repellent is not recommended for children under 3–5 years of age.

The product is safe for skin application. Its safety has been confirmed by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA, USA), and many other international authorities. It has been used in Europe for more than 30 years as a repellent, with no reports of serious side effects.

In addition to skin application, the product is intended for use on clothing. Before use, it is recommended to test on an inconspicuous part of the garment, as, like many other repellents, it may be incompatible with certain synthetic materials. Applying repellent to clothing is particularly important in high-risk areas, as some insect bites may penetrate clothing. Ticks may remain unnoticed on clothing for several hours before reaching exposed skin.

Precautions

Avoid direct spraying on the face; protect eyes, mouth, and nose.

In case of individual sensitivity, allergic reactions may occur.

Read the label and product information before use.

First Aid

In case of improper use or concerning symptoms, consult a doctor.

In case of contact with eyes: rinse thoroughly with clean water.

If swallowed: rinse mouth with water.

If inhaled: ensure access to fresh air.

Storage Conditions

Store in a dry, cool place, out of reach of children.

Shelf Life

2 years.

Packaging

100 ml white polyethylene bottle with spray nozzle and protective cap;

100 ml aluminum aerosol can with spray nozzle and protective cap.
